



### Artistic Team New Protocols

\*All new protocols will be followed through the month of June & *tentatively* July

**Restarting/Opening Date:** May 26th, 2020- We will be opening our DYER facility starting Tuesday May 26th to ALL team members. The facility will open to recreational classes starting June 1st, 2020. The week of May 26th will strictly be a conditioning and basics week. We will take this time to get the athletes back into the swing of practice, and start building their muscles up before returning to a regular training practice. There will be NO FEE charged for this week in May. Regular billing will start on June 1st, 2020.

#### **Social Distancing Artistic Team Guidelines:**

- All equipment will be sanitized between each rotation throughout class.
- 6 feet of social distancing will be maintained by markings on the floor.
- There will be no use of cubbies/lockers in the facility. We ask that each child brings their own bag to contain all of their belongings. Including but not limited to- shoes, water bottles, grips
- There will be no use of water fountains in the facility.
- All students will be required to wear socks or gymnastics slippers which can be found in our proshop- NO EXCEPTIONS
- Siblings and additional spectators not participating in class are not allowed in the facility.

#### **New Class Format:**

- Entering/Existing class protocol: We ask that everyone comes in the front main door, and exits the specified door when their practice is over.  
*What does this mean?* When entering the facility you will go through the main entrance. At the end of class your instructor will indicate which side door you will be using to exit. All doors will be marked on the outside with what classes will be exiting through which door- this way if you choose to wait in the car for your child you will know exactly what door to look for your child out of.
