



Novice/Expert Tumbling & Adult Tumbling New Protocols

*All new protocols will be followed through the month of June & tentatively July

Restarting/Opening Date: June 1st, 2020

Social Distancing Novice/Expert Tumbling & Adult Tumbling Class Guidelines:

- All equipment will be sanitized between each rotation throughout class.
- 6 feet of social distancing will be maintained by markings on the floor.
- There will be no use of cubbies/lockers in the facility. We ask that each child brings their own bag to contain all of their belongings. Including but not limited to- shoes, water bottles, grips
- There will be no use of water fountains in the facility.
- All students will be required to wear socks- NO EXCEPTIONS
- Siblings and additional spectators not participating in class are not allowed in the facility.

New Class Format:

- Entering/Existing class protocol: We ask that everyone comes in the front main door, and exits the specified door when their practice is over.
What does this mean? When entering the facility you will go through the main entrance. At the end of class your instructor will indicate which side door you will be using to exit. All doors will be marked on the outside with what classes will be exiting through which door- this way if you choose to wait in the car for your child you will know exactly what door to look for your child out of.

Make-Up Classes: To schedule a make-up class for the 2 weeks missed in March due to the facility closure you will need to call the front desk to schedule. You will be able to make-up in any other Novice/Expert Tumbling & Adult Tumbling class as long as there is availability.
